In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however, the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission /registration/ obtaining loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.


Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:


1. The school will follow the **RTE Act, 2009** and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
5. The school should go through the provision of **Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy there of** for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
6. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
7. **Admission to the school** is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.4.2, 8.4.10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
8. The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Education.
9. The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
11. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment conservation and cleanliness etc
12. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website: www.cbse.nic.in
13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
14. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly its bonafide and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without break or inform with reasons thereof in writing well in time about the non-sponsoring of the candidates.
15. Running of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
16. The Manger and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online/offline documents/information/data submitted by the School to the Board.
17. Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for drawing specific attention of the school authorities, the school authorities are required to acquaint themselves with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-laws and circulars/guidelines/notification issued by the Board from time to time. Any laxity in following rules/instructions of the Board will lead to action against school as per clause 12 of Affiliation Bye-laws-2018.
18. The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018
19. The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show case /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of date/information sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation
20. The school is required to remit pending fee, if any

22. The school shall renew all mandatory safety certificate i.e Safe Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt authorities time to time
23. The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, failing which necessary action shall be taken as per Affiliation-Bye-Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt., in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms
24. The Board reserves the-right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.

Recognition was accorded for classes Pre - Primary to VII (E.M) for the academic year 2011-12 vide reference 4th read above, in respect of St Mars V Hs, Pregnapur, Gajwel Mandal, Gajwel(ward No.4)(v), Gajwel(m), Siddipet(dist).

The Correspondent of St Mars V Hs, Pregnapur, Gajwel Mandal, Gajwel(ward No.4)(v), Gajwel(m), Siddipet(dist) has submitted the proposals for grant of Renewal Recognition of classes Pre - Primary to VII (E.M) (with four sections) from the year 2021-22 to 2030-31.

The Mandal Education Officer, Gajwel, Siddipet has verified the proposals with reference to the conditions laid down in the Recognition orders and GO Ms No 1/Edn, Dated: 01-01-1994 and subsequent Government Orders submitted a detailed report through the letter under reference 4th read above.

After careful examination of the proposals of the Correspondent and report of the Mandal Education Officer, Gajwel, Siddipet in the reference 4th read above, the District Educational Officer, Siddipet is pleased to accord the Renewal Recognition of Classes Pre - Primary to VII (E.M) for a period of ten (10) years from 2021-22 to 2030-31 in respect of St Mars V Hs, Pregnapur, Gajwel Mandal, Gajwel(ward No.4)(v), Gajwel(m), Siddipet(dist). The management is requested to follow the conditions.

1. The above Renewal Recognition is accorded purely on a temporary basis and is subjected to the reports of State Level Inspection and Vigilance Committee fulfilling of all the pre requisite condition under the A.P Education Act 1982 and if later found that the school has not fulfilled any pre requisites as stipulated, the Renewal Recognition now being given is liable to be withdrawn at any time.

2. That the society shall abide to the rules and regulations made in the Govt. Orders 1st cited and subsequent orders.

- facilities, drinking water facilities, furniture, Library, Laboratory, equipment play field required staff as per the staff pattern another facilities.
4. That the Renewal Recognition is accorded to the St Marys Educationa Society.
 5. The Renewal Recognition is accorded to run the school in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises of locality specified in the orders.
 6. The management should follow the G.O.Ms.No.22 ,dated 18-07-2017 i.e ., the weight of the school bag not to exceed 4kg for VI-VII,4.5 kg for VIII-IX and 5 kg for X.
 7. That the administrative report and the audited statement of accounts of the school duly attested by the Chartered accountant for every financial year shall be submitted to the District Educational Officer, latest by September
 8. The Management has to follow the government norms from time to time, for collection of fee from students.
 9. That educational agency shall not use the premises building, play ground and vacant site belongs to the institution for any purpose other than the Educational activities and conducting authorized examinations without permission of DEO.
 10. The management should follow the guidelines issued in G.O.Ms. No. 36., School Education (General) Dept., Dt:- 16-12-2017 for the safety and security of the children in the schools.
 11. The management should pay the mandate taxes due to the concerned departments as per schedule fixed by the Government,
 12. The school shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services departments
 13. The school shall have 'first aid-kit' and the teachers shall be trained in first aid.
 14. That any children studied in recognized school of other states/countries affiliated to the bodies recognized by the state or central government shall not be admitted without prior permission of the District Educational Officer/Director of School Education.
 15. That the management shall not collect any fees or donations either in cash or kind other than the fees prescribed by the governing body from pupils or parents or any other person or on their behalf for any purpose.
 16. That educational agency shall not force any member of the staff or students of the institutions to take part in the religious discourses and preaching of religion irrespective of whether they belong to the same belief or not.
 17. If the Management provides transportation, it is the responsibility of the Management to submit Fitness Certificates of their buses every year regularly to the D.E.O. to have skilled, Trained, Licensed and healthy driver. If any deviation in this matter, they will be personally held responsible.
 18. The Correspondent should submit Renewal of Recognition proposals before 90 days of the expiry of Renewal Recognition.

19. The Educational Agency should Implement the Guidelines for Safe and Effective use of Internet & Digital Technologies in schools and school buses issued by CBSE vide Circular No.Acad-32/2017, dated 18.08.2017 communicated by MHRD, Govt. of India.

20. The Educational Agency should Implement the Model Education Code prepared by National University for Educational Planning and Administration in 2015

21. That educational agency shall not permit the students of any D.Ed/B.Ed colleges or college of physical education or any teacher training institution to have teaching practice without the permission of the District Educational Officer.

22. Proper and adequate parking area for vehicles shall be provided transporting the children to and from the school.

23. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.

24. The Parent Teachers Associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the children


25. The school shall constitute Committees for redressal of the Public/ Staff/ Parents/ Students grievances, Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Committees under POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) Act, 2012 and details of these Committees along with contact details shall be displayed prominently on School Notice Board and conspicuously on the School Website for the information of all the stakeholders.

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Permission/ Extension of Temporary Recognition has been accorded to the Class (s) VIII to X (E.M) for the years 2008-2009 to 2017-2018 in respect of St.Mary's Vidyaniketan High School, Pragnapur, Gajwel(M), Siddipet District in the orders 5th cited. The inspecting authority i.e., the District Educational Officer, Siddipet District has submitted the report for provisional recognition to the school for the years 2018-2019 to 2027-2028 with reference to the conditions laid down in the permission order/previous recognition orders and G.O Ms.No.1Edn, (PS.2) Dept, dt.01.01.1994 vide reference 6th cited.

After careful examination of the references cited and the conditions prescribed in G.O. Ms. No.1Edn, (PS.2) Dept, dt.01.01.1994 and based on the recommendations of the DEO, Siddipet Dist., the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Hyderabad hereby accorded Provisional/ Extension of Temporary Recognition to Class(s) VIII to X (E.M) for the years, 2018-2019 to 2027-2028 in respect of St.Mary's Vidyaniketan High School, Pragnapur, Gajwel(M), Siddipet Dist. subject to fulfillment of conditions as detailed below:

1. That the Educational Society shall abide by the instructions/rules issued by the Govt. from time to time.
2. That the educational Society shall serve the needs of locality more particularly.
3. That the institution shall adopt the curriculum and syllabus prescribed from time to time by the State Government.
4. That the school timings, vacations and mid-term holidays shall be as prescribed by Govt. from time to time.
5. That the qualified staff within age limits prescribed by the Govt. for Government employees shall be appointed as per the staff pattern as per G.O Ms.No.103 Edn (PS), dt.05-08-2005.
6. That the results shall be satisfactory every year and not to be announce the ranks in SSC Public Examinations as per the G.O Ms.No.49 Edn. (PS), dt.26.02.98.
7. That the records/accounts shall be furnished to the D.E.O every year by 31st March, at the latest.
8. That the list of governing body shall be furnished to the DEO every year.
9. That the pay structure / fee structure fixed by the governing body shall be got approved by the DEO every year.
10. That all the conditions prescribed in G.Os and other orders which are not specified in this order shall complied with.


11. That the school shall not be closed without giving notice both the Parents/DEO and competent authority at least (6) months before.
12. That the school shall be closed or permitted to be closed only from the date on which summer vacation is declared.
13. That the society shall submit proposals for renewal of provisional recognition sufficiently in advance i.e., at least (6) months prior to the date of expiry of the renewal.
14. That additional sections/higher classes should not be opened without prior permission of the competent authority.
15. That the recognition is accorded to society and no other society or body can open a school on their behalf.
16. The recognition is accorded to open the school premises in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises or locality.
17. The society shall provide the necessary material even if it costs more than the deposit amount.
18. Admissions should be made on the basis Record sheet issued by the Private Recognized/ZP/Govt/Aided schools only T.Cs/Certificates issued by the Secretary, DCEB as Bonafide candidate.
19. The Edn. Society shall file an affidavit to the effect that there is no deviation or violation of norms/rules prescribed by Govt. from time to time by the end of April every year as per G.O.3rd cited.
20. The above E.T.R. is granted subject to condition that, If it is found later that the school has not fulfilled the prerequisite condition under A.P. Edn. Act 1982, reported by State Level Inspection Team and Vigilance Committee, the E.T.R. now being granted is liable to be withdrawn at once.
21. The Management shall provide sufficient transportation, sufficient fire extinguishers in the school.
22. The Management is totally responsible in all aspects for the safety of school children. They will be personally held responsible if any incident occurs.
23. The Management shall handover the school premises whenever required to this department / Government for emergency purpose (Exams/ Elections etc.) without any deviation of the orders.
24. The Management shall renew NOC from Fire Department from time to time without fail.

The recognition now granted is liable for withdrawal by the competent authority for violating the rule as prescribed in the G.O's cited and instructions issued by the authority from time to time.


